Do you need help applying to the National Redress Scheme?

You can apply to the scheme if:

- You have experienced institutional child sexual abuse before 1 July 2018
- You are aged **over 18** years or turning 18 before 30th June 2028
- The institution responsible for the sexual abuse has joined the Scheme
- You apply between 1 July 2018 and 30 June 2027
